TOWN OF HARPERSFIELD TRANSFER STATION RECYCLING RULES

A TRANSFER STATION STICKER IS REQUIRED BEFORE YOU WILL BE ALLOWED TO DUMP YOUR GARBAGE AT THE TRANSFER STATION. TO GET A TRANSFER STATION STICKER CONTACT YOUR TOWN CLERK/TAX COLLECTOR.

THE DAYS AND TIMES THAT THE TRANSFER STATION IS OPEN ARE LISTED ON THE STICKER. PLEASE CHECK BY CALLING THE TRANSFER STATION AT 607-652-7909 TO SEE IF IT WILL BE OPEN ON FEDERAL HOLIDAYS.

CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS ARE REQUIRED FOR BOTH GARBAGE & RECYCLABLES. ALL BLACK BAGS MUST BE OPENED BEFORE DISPOSAL.

Recyclables – Glass, Cans & Plastic may be put in the same bag. Paper and clean dry cardboard are to be placed in separate containers.

GLASS:

- 1. Containers must be recycled.
- 2. Containers should be rinsed clean and free of contamination, labels may be left on.
- 3. Metal or plastic caps MUST be removed, throw them away with the regular trash.
- 4. Labels may be left on.
- 5. DO NOT RECYCLE THE FOLLOWING: WINDOW GLASS, MIRRORS, LIGHT BULBS OR TUBES, POTTERY OR CROCKS, TOILETS, PLATE GLASS, NO BROKEN JARS AND/OR BOTTLES.

CANS:

- 1. Steel and aluminum food and beverages containers must be recycled.
- 2. The containers should be rinsed clean and free of contamination, labels may be left on.
- 3. Clean pie plates, cake tins and aluminum foil can be recycled.
- 4. DO NOT RECYCLE THE FOLLOWING: PROPANE OR FLAMMABLE GAS CONTAINERS.

PLASTIC:

- 1. Plastic containers must be recycled.
- 2. Look for the Recycling Emblem on the bottom or side of the container. Recycle #'s 1, 2 & 3.
- 3. Lids are to be removed and containers rinsed clean, labels can be left on.
- 4. DO NOT RECYCLE THE FOLLOWING: PLASTIC WRAP, PLASTIC SILVERWARE, PLASTIC BAGS, STYROFOAM, PLASTIC PIPE OR HOSE.

PAPER:

- 1. Paper including books, newspaper, magazines, catalogs and junk mail are recyclable.
- 2. Material must be put into the bin loose. NO BAGS, STRING OR WIRE.
- 3. NO HARD COVERED BOOKS ARE TO BE PUT INTO THIS CONTAINER.

CARDBOARD:

- 1. All corrugated cardboard is recyclable (corrugated cardboard has wavy material between layers.
- 2. Brown paper bags can be put into this category.
- 3. DO NOT RECYCLE THE FOLLOWING: FOOD BOXES, POSTER BOARD, PIZZA BOXES, MAILING & SHIPPING TUBES AND PACKING PAPER.

BATTERIES:

All size batteries must be recycled. Please put the small ones in the barrel or barrels in front of the recycle table. Large batteries may be left on the floor by the barrels.

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS:

- 1. Includes bulky debris: furniture, siding, drywall, plaster, plumbing, roofing, treated or painted wood, flooring, mattresses, hoses, tubing, tarps and bale wrap.
- 2. One 55 gallon drum per day.

TIRES:

- 1. Over the road car and truck tires less than 24 inches may be put in the trailer at the Transfer Station.
- 2. NO OFF ROAD TIRES ARE ACCEPTED.

BULK METAL:

- 1. All bulk metal is to be recycled in a separate container.
- 2. Includes: steel, metal frames, sheet metal, car parts, CLEAN AND DRY PAINT CANS, wire and appliances.
- 3. Any propane tanks must be empty and have valves removed.
- 4. Remove nonmetal portions of wood, fabric, plastic, etc.
- 5. NO FREON CONTAINING ITEMS.

FREON CONTAINING ITEMS:

- 1. All Freon containing items MUST be recycled.
- 2. Includes refrigerator, freezers, air conditioners and dehumidifiers.
- 3. All door must be removed.
- 4. Ask the attendant for the location to dispose.

ELECTRONICS:

- 1. Includes all materials with a mother board and circuitry.
- 2. Computers, cell phones, TVs, tablets, printers, etc.
- 3. NO TOASTERS OR VACUUM CLEANERS.

YARD WASTE - NOT ACCEPTED.
